From Bishop Martin Hayes I wish to advise the faithful that the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days remains suspended at this time and every person should consider carefully if returning to collective worship is the safe and appropriate step for them at this time. Liturgies can continue to be streamed via webcam.

Mass can be attended up to fifty people social distancing commencing on the 10th. May. Masses said in Doobally Church and can be listened to on radio 106.4fm. I wish to welcome back those people who wish to return to Mass at this time. It has seemed to me a long time since Christmas Eve when the last public Mass was said. Since then some parishioners have lost loved ones and we pray that they be comforted and consoled.

It has been a strange time for me saying Mass in an empty church and I am sure strange for you listening and being unable to attend. However there have been vast improvements since then, with more people vaccinated and the numbers in hospital much lower than in previous months. Needless to say we still must be careful and I ask you, as before when you return to Mass to follow the advice of the Ushers, Sanitise your hands, Wear a mask and keep two metres apart. We are not out of the wood yet but we can see light.

Thank you for your support in so many ways during the past months. This support is greatly appreciated and I have no doubt you will continue with this support. As you are aware this has been a difficult time financially for all parishes but with your help and support we will be able to continue maintaining the Parish Churches in good condition inviting for people to pray and worship.
